### **Tournament format**

#### Qualification

6 Games entries and re-entries

#### **Desperado definition**

3 highest game Qualifies to final round 1

#### 35 Athletes will qualify for the final steps

A: 32 athletes from the general standing

B: 3 athletes from the desperado

#### The 35 athletes are qualified to final steps as follows

Athletes positioned 1-10 in the general standing are qualified for the Final step 2 Athletes positioned 11-32 in the general standing + 3 from desperado are qualified for step 1

#### Final step 1

25 athletes are playing 5 games starting from scratch. 5 players per pair of lanes Athletes positioned 1-10 is qualified for the final step 2 Athletes not qualified are ranked 21-35 according to their position in step 1

#### Final step 2

20 athletes are playing 5 games starting from scratch. 4 players per pair of lanes Athletes positioned 1-10 is qualified for the final step 3 Athletes not qualified are ranked 11-20 according to their position in step 2

#### Final step 3

10 athletes are playing 5 games. Pins carry forward from final step 2. 2 players per pair of lanes

Athletes positioned 1-4 is qualified for the final step 4

Athletes not qualified are ranked 5-10 according to their position in step 3

## Final step 4

Top 4 athletes are playing 1 game in a carousel from scratch Athlete with lowest result are not qualified for final step 5 and will be ranked 4 according to the position in step 4



## Final step 5

Top 3 athletes are playing 1 game in a carousel and pins will carry forward Athlete with lowest result are not qualified for final step 6 and will be ranked 3 according to the position in step 5

## Final step 6

Top 2 athletes are playing 1 game in a carousel and pins will carry forward Winner is the athlete with the highest total score from final step 4,5 and 6 The athlete with lowest score from final step 4,5 and 6 will be ranked 2 according to the position in step 6

## Tournament tie rules

### Qualification

The highest positioned athlete will be the athlete scoring the highest last game. If a tie still exist,, the highest positioned athlete will be the athlete with the highest second last game etc.

## Desperado

In case of tie, one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

## Final Step 1-3

Ties influencing who will qualify for the next final step will be broken by playing a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off, repeated until the tie is broken. In all other tie situations in step 1-3, a procedure similar to the procedure for the qualification will be followed

## Final Step 4-6

In case of tie, one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken

# General guidelines for the Tournament Application

The filled in application must be emailed to Kim Thorsgaard Jensen at the email address <a href="https://ktj@etbf.eu">ktj@etbf.eu</a>. Only applications received by email will be accepted.

Please use a combination of capital letters and small letters and <u>not capital letters only</u>. This combination is the standard for <u>www.etbf.eu</u>.

Please write in English, since the language of <u>www.etbf.eu</u> is English only.

## Guidelines for the group: Tournament status

Tournament name The field must be filled in with the name of the tournament.

<u>EBT status</u> The field is only for tournaments adopted in the European Bowling Tour. Field format: EBT 20XX-99 / Category

ETBF Tournament

The field is pre-filled with a Yes. If the field "World Bowling Tournament" is either empty or filled in with a No, only athletes from ETBF member federations can participate in the tournament and not athletes from any other zone.

World Bowling Tournament

If you want the tournament to be open for athletes from other zones than ETBF, then the field must be filled in with a Yes.

<u>Tournament website</u> One or more website addresses can be inserted. Field format: <u>www.tournament.eu</u>

## **Guidelines for the group: Other Tournament Series**

Name of the series The field must be filled in with the name of the series.

<u>Period of the series</u> The field must be filled in with the period of the series, typically a season or a calendar year.

<u>Stop number in the series</u> The field must be filled with a two digit number, for instance 01 or 07 etc.

<u>Website of the series</u> One website addresses can be inserted. Field format: <u>www.tournament.eu</u>



Source of rules of the series One website addresses can be inserted. Field format: <u>www.tournament.eu</u>

# Guidelines for the group: Tournament information

<u>Tournament organizer</u> The field must be filled in, either with the name of the tournament organizer or the organization hosting the tournament.

<u>Centre</u>

The field must be filled in with the name of the centre, in which the tournament is conducted.

<u>City</u>

The field must be filled in with the name of the city, where the tournament takes place.

<u>Federation</u> The field must be filled in with the name of the Federation, where the tournament takes place.

<u>First day</u> The field must be filled in with the first day of the tournament. Field format: 12 January 2017

<u>Last day</u>

The field must be filled in with the last day of the tournament. Field format: 19 January 2017

# **Guidelines for the group: Tournament delimitations**

<u>Category</u>

The field must be filled in, either with "Open" or with "Invitational", if the tournament is limited to certain groups of athletes.

<u>Event</u> The field can include one or more events. Field format 1: Singles Mixed Field format 2: Singles Women / Singles Men / Doubles Mixed

<u>Women handicap</u> If women and men are playing in a mixed division, then the field can be filled in with an eventual handicap per game. Field format; X pins per game

Max women scratch game

This field is only valid if a handicap for women is applicable in the tournament. The field must then be filled with for instance 300 or less, if the organizer reduces the maximum of women scratch games, for instance to 292 if the handicap is 8.



Other kind of handicaps

If other kind of handicaps, than handicaps for women exists, then the field must be filled in with the size of the handicaps and to whom they are given.

## **Guidelines for the group: Tournament contact**

<u>Contact person</u> The field must be filled in with the name of at least one contact person.

<u>Mobile</u>

The field must be filled in with the mobile number of at least one contact person. Field format: +99 999 999 999

<u>Email</u>

The field must be filled in with the email address of at least one contact person. Field format: <u>name@organizer.eu</u>

<u>Registration</u>

The field must be filled in with a website address or a text.

## **Guidelines for the group: Centre address**

Address

The field must be filled in with the address of the centre, where the tournament is held. Field format: The name of the centre

Address and street number Postal number and city Country

<u>Phone</u> The field must be filled in with the phone number of the centre. Field format: +99 999 999

<u>Email</u>

The field must be filled in with an eventual email address of the centre. Field format: <a href="mailto:name@centre.eu">name@centre.eu</a>

<u>Website</u>

The field must be filled in with an eventual website address of the centre. Field format: <u>www.centre.eu</u>

## **Guidelines for the group: Centre specifications**

Number of lanes

The field must be filled in with the number of lanes in the centre.



Approaches

The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the lane approaches.

<u>Surfaces</u> The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the lane surfaces.

<u>Pin decks</u> The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the pin decks.

<u>Pin setters</u> The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the pin setters.

<u>Pins</u>

The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the pins.

Score system

The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the score system.

## Guidelines for the group: Dressing specifications

<u>Oil machine</u> The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the oil machine.

Oil

The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the oil.

<u>Cleaner</u>

The field must be filled in with the brand and type of the cleaner.

Pattern prepared by The field can be filled in with a name, a company or the centre.

<u>Dressing done by</u> The field can be filled in with a name, a company or the centre.

# **Guidelines for the group: Prize money specifications**

<u>Prize fund status</u> The field can be filled with either "Fixed" or "Conditional".

Calculation method

If the prize fund status is "Conditional", this field must include a complete calculation method of the conditional prize fund based on number of athletes, when the number of athletes changes the prize fund etc. If the prize fund status is filled with "Fixed", the field can be deleted.

Tax on prizes

The field can be filled with either "Yes" or "No".

Tax rules

If the prizes are taxed, this field must include a complete explanation on how the taxes are calculated and if there are any exceptions etc. If prizes are tax free, the field can be deleted.

## Guidelines for the group: Prize money expressed in €

<u>Prize money expressed in  $\in$ </u> The currency of the prizes is listed as  $\in$ , but it can be changed to the currency code you prefer.

<u>Position</u>

You can add more positions if needed or extract them to for instance "Position 9-12".

<u>Category</u> Fill in the category for the prizes, for instance "Singles Mixed". Divide in more columns, if there are more than one category.

## Guidelines for the group: Tournament format

This field must include a full description of each stage of the tournament; often including a qualification and a number of final steps.

Each step explanation must as a minimum include: The number of games in the step The number of athletes to continue to the next step If the pin fall is carried forward to the next step How not qualified athletes and losers of a stage or a matches will be ranked

## Guidelines for the group: Tournament tie rules

Tie rules for all steps in the tournament must be specified, such as: The qualification The desperado squad The Turbo Various final steps with pin falls Various final steps with head to head matches

## **Guidelines for the group: Lane assignment and lane movements**

<u>Lane draws</u> We recommend the following text: "By impartial notaries public".

<u>Athletes per pair in squads</u> Present the number of athletes per pair of lanes in qualification squads.

## Frequency of movement

The field can be filled with for instance: "After each game" or "After each second game".



<u>Movement method</u> The field can be filled with for instance: "Left lanes moves left, right lanes moves right".

<u>Number of lanes to move</u> The field can be filled with for instance: "Two lanes in small and four lanes in big squads".

## Guidelines for the group: Booking policies

Booking restriction before

For a re-entry tournament we recommend the filed to be filled in with "A maximum of three squads can be booked before the tournament starts and maximum two of the bookings can be for squads on Friday and Saturday".

Booking restriction during

The field can be filled with "Unlimited" or a text indicating a restriction.

<u>Total number of bookings</u> The field can be filled with "Unlimited" or a text indicating a restriction.

Booking cancellations

Then the text is either "Possible" or "Impossible". We strongly recommend "Possible" as the most normal and natural for a re-entry tournament.

<u>Registration deadline</u> The text can either be "none" or "XX minutes before", where XX can be maximum 30.

# Guidelines for the group: Qualification squads and fees in €

<u>Qualification squads and fees in  $\in$ </u> The currency of the fees is listed as  $\in$ , but it can be changed to the currency code you prefer.

<u>Squad</u>

The squad numbers are pre-filled. You can remove lines with not used squad numbers or add more lines if more squads are in use.

<u>Day</u>

For each squad, insert the day. Field format: Monday, Tuesday etc.

<u>Date</u> For each squad, insert the date. Field format: DD.MM.YYYY

<u>Time</u> For each squad, insert the time. Field format: 99.99



### <u>Spots</u>

For each squad, insert the number of spots available for the spot. You are not obligated to provide all lanes in the centre for each squad, so the number of available spots can vary from squad to squad.

### Entry Fee

For each squad, insert the entry fee for the squad. Field format: 999 (no comma, no currency)

### Re-entry

For each squad, insert the re-entry fee for the squad. Field format: 999 (no comma, no currency)

## Guidelines for the group: Schedule for the final steps

Present a line for each lane maintenance and final step, as follows: 08.00: Lane maintenance 09.00: Final Step 1 11.00: Lane maintenance 12.00: Final step 2. Etc. 18.00: Award ceremony

## Guidelines for the group: Hotels provided by the organizer

If it is possible to order accommodation at hotels with agreements with the organizer (either through the organizer or through the hotel directly), the hotels can be listed in this field to-gether with their addresses, contact information and hotel rates etc.

You can eventually limit the field content to be a reference to the tournament website.

## Guidelines for the group: Other information

The field might be used for any other kind of additional tournament information at your choice. The amount of information must be within reasonable limits.
